Research ethics was considered throughout the study. Participant's information, oral consent form obtained.

### **VI. Analysis**

The reasons were analyzed by frequency and percentage.

### **VII. Major findings of the Study**

Regarding the open ended reasons:

- Out of 32 respondents nearly 28 per cent said that parental misguidance of the spouse is the main reason for seeking divorce;
- About 19 per cent said that they receive psychological threats (5) from their spouses and hence they applied divorce
- Unstable emotional behavior and aggressiveness (6) of the spouse are the reasons for divorce, according to six per cent of respondents;
- A similar percentage of people aspire for divorce each cited the reasons, settling in a foreign country, and lower estimation of spouse's family, misuse of law.(7)
- Other reasons cited include lying, always money oriented, arrogance & cunning, vast age difference, and showing too much anger.

### **VIII. Conclusion**

Findings revealed that parental misguidance was the prime most reason for divorce in present study.

### **IX Limitation**

Since the sample number is miniscule and there were no comparison group result is only limited to the targeted population.

### **X. Implications**

Divorce in India is on the rise while the professionals should aware the preventive measures to stop the contagious burden of the society.
